### **The Skinny on the Hotel**

This year's reunion site is the Hilton Orlando located at 6001 Destination Parkway (formerly Canadian Court), Orlando (phone) 407-313-4300. The VHPA group rate is \$119 per night during the period 1 July to 14 July. In addition to the free self parking, internet access is also free to attendees.

There are three ways to make a reservation: Hilton's group services have established a personalized website specifically for this reunion. Simply go to [www.hilton.com/en/hi/groups/personalized/ORLOCHH-VHP-20110704/index.jhtml?WT.mc\\_id=POG](http://www.hilton.com/en/hi/groups/personalized/ORLOCHH-VHP-20110704/index.jhtml?WT.mc_id=POG). Click on the attendee's link immediately below the American flag. You can also scroll down on the initial screen and click the Book a Room tab in the 'quick and Easy Reservations for Attendees' area. Either action gets you to the 'Dates

and Preferences' screen. Provide your arrival and departure dates, room type preference, make certain the code VHP is entered in the Group/Convention field and click the continue tab. This gets you to the 'Rooms and Rates' screen. Make certain to click the 'radio button' under the VHPA NATL REUNION section, then click the Continue tab. This gets you to the guest information screen. After you complete the required fields in this screen, click the 'Book Now' tab at the bottom of the screen. This gets you to the Confirmation screen. You can call the Hilton's toll free reservation line at 888-488-3509. You should say you want to make a hotel reservation and you need to mention any number of keywords such as "VHP", "VHPA", or "VHPA National Reunion" so the agent can find the contract and set you up at the correct rate. You can also call the Hilton's toll free central reservations number, 800-445-8667. You should guide the agent to the Hilton Orlando property and use the keywords outlined above to find the Contract.

### **The TOC & the Main Event - THE MINI**

Once again, we have a great TOC lined up for this year. Our TOC is scheduled to be the Clear Lake Room, located adjacent to the registration area. There may be some room shuffling so be sure to check in the registration where the TOC will actually be

The mini reunion is scheduled for Friday, July 8th beginning at 1300. WE are currently scheduled to have our mini in the Lake George A room. Once again, be sure to check and confirm the location.

Once again, the VHPA is providing us with a TOC for the entire reunion period. Our TOC is scheduled to be in the Clear Lake room. The Clear Lake room is located across from the main registration area. We are also planning to have draft beer on tap. We will be asking for your donation for a beer. Right now, it looks like 3 bucks a draft will cover most of our costs. Basically, if we buy the draft beer from the hotel, we get the room for practically nothing. While the TOC operating costs have hopefully decreased this year, we still need to solicit your contributions to continue to make it happen and build our war chest for future reunion activities. Last year was our first experience with the draft beer thing and requesting a donation per beer. Quite truthfully, it didn't work out too well. We had a lot of folks drinking beer but not many making donations. We'll give it another shot again this year and see how it goes. Williamsburg Woodlands Hotel & Suites, one of the Colonial Williamsburg Hotels, is located directly across from the Colonial Williamsburg Visitors' Center. The room rate for a standard room (2 double beds) for single or double occupancy is \$89 per night; king size suites including queen size sofa are available for \$119 per night; complimentary continental breakfast included. The special guest room rates will apply three days before and after the event. A GP medium and cots will be provided in an adjacent wooded area for select individuals.

**Event Dates:** Wednesday, November 9<sup>th</sup> - Sunday, November 13<sup>th</sup>, 2011

**Reservations:** For reservations, call 800-261-9530 between the hours of 0830 and 1700 EST. Use booking code #17008 or Group Name '48<sup>th</sup> AHC'. **Reservations must be made prior to Wednesday, September 7, 2011.** Reservation must be accompanied by one night's deposit for room plus tax. Reservations made after September 7<sup>th</sup>, will be based on a space and rate available basis. Individual deposits are refundable, provided notice of cancelation is received by the hotel by 1700 EST at least 3 business days prior to reserved date of arrival.

**Arrival & Departure Times:** Check-in time is 1600. Check-out time is 1100.
